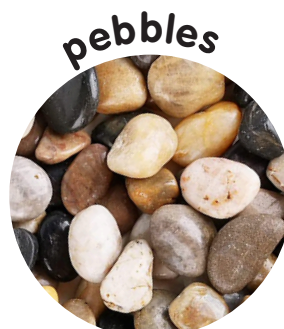




HEY! It's all about... loose parts play
