

Better Place Nurture Naturelets Project



Nurture Naturelets was a collaboration led by Better Place (a Better Start Bradford Project) Thanks to additional funding of £47k from Natural England, Better Place have used creative and novel ways to connect expectant parents and families with 0-3s with nature.



£71 thousand invested in Nurture Naturelets



451 families attended 39 creative nature sessions



2 murals installed (Peel Park & Mary Street)



61 families attended 6 field trips



52 families received mini habitats for their outdoor spaces



101 trees and pollinator species given to 52 families



80 nature themed items gifted to families



217 families attended 23 mini beast and nature sessions



200 families attended 4 Wild Workshops



15 forest bathing sessions delivered



If we nurture nature, nature will nurture us



510 families attended 4 large community events including the **Lovely Bug Ball** at Bowling Park

In 2024/25 we delivered **94** Nature Nurture sessions to **1,493** families

Over 278 hours of outdoor nature connection sessions in all seasons and all weathers – that's about 5 hours per week!

1 community sculptural installation made up of 16 dragonflies

50 Bug wings loaned for Lovely Bug Ball
